## 2022: THE YEAR TO HONOR TEXAS LEGENDS

Texans are the stuff of legend. This is not new. It goes back to our fight for independence when men like Sam Houston, Jim Bowie, Stephen F. Austin, William Travis, and Davey Crockett were immortalized for their service and sacrifice. Some were Texans by birth, others by choice. Some gave their lives, others achieved victory and independence, going on to continue their service in the chambers of government.

In this edition of TCR, we honor our Texas legends and celebrate three Texas patriots who serve our state in that great tradition.

Dan Crenshaw is a hero and a patriot. While serving our country as part of Seal Team Three, he was critically injured by an IED in Afghanistan. The explosion took his right eye and severely damaged his left. Despite medical predictions that he would never see again, Crenshaw defied the odds to not only see again, but to retrain with limited vision and rejoin the Seals for two more deployments. He left the service with two Bronze Stars, the Purple Heart, and the Navy Commendation Medal with Valor.

After his discharge in 2016, Crenshaw earned a master's degree from Harvard University and in 2018 ran to represent Texas' 2nd District in the US House. Once again Crenshaw, the underdog, defied the odds and won election against two well-funded opponents, one of whom spent more than \$7 million.

After his election, Crenshaw hit the ground running, passing more bills through the House of Representatives during his first term than any other Republican freshman and passed two bills under President Trump to boost American energy innovation and protect Texas oil and gas. Crenshaw has been the strongest, most vocal critic of Joe Biden's disastrous policies, especially his attacks on Texas energy and the crisis he created at our southern border.

In Congress, like on the battlefield, Crenshaw proved to be a determined

warrior. He defended President Trump's border policies on The View, stood up to liberal MSNBC commentators regarding the sham-impeachment claims, and then faced off with liberal Bill Maher in defense of President Trump's COVID policies.

Dan Crenshaw is a fighter and a hero. He is also a 6th generation Texan who embodies the Texas spirit.

Like Dan Crenshaw, Governor Greg Abbott overcame adversity to rise to the highest office in the state of Texas. In 1984, at the age of 26, Greg Abbott was struck by a falling tree while jogging, leaving him paralyzed. After enduring a long and excruciating recovery, Abbott responded to the adversity by entering private practice as an attorney. In 1992, he ran for and won election as a district judge, where he served until 1995 when he was appointed to serve as a justice on the Texas Supreme Court. Abbott was elected the 50th Attorney General in Texas history, serving Texans in that post until 2015 when he took office as Governor.

As Governor, Greg Abbott has continued his distinguished record of service on behalf of Texans, creating over one million new jobs, improving roads, and cutting taxes. Abbott has also made an unprecedented \$1 billion investment into border security with Operation Lone Star— which deploys air, ground, marine, and tactical border security assets to high threat areas to deny Mexican Cartels, smugglers, and human traffickers the ability to move drugs and people into Texas—along with continuing the border wall construction begun by President Trump but halted by Joe Biden.

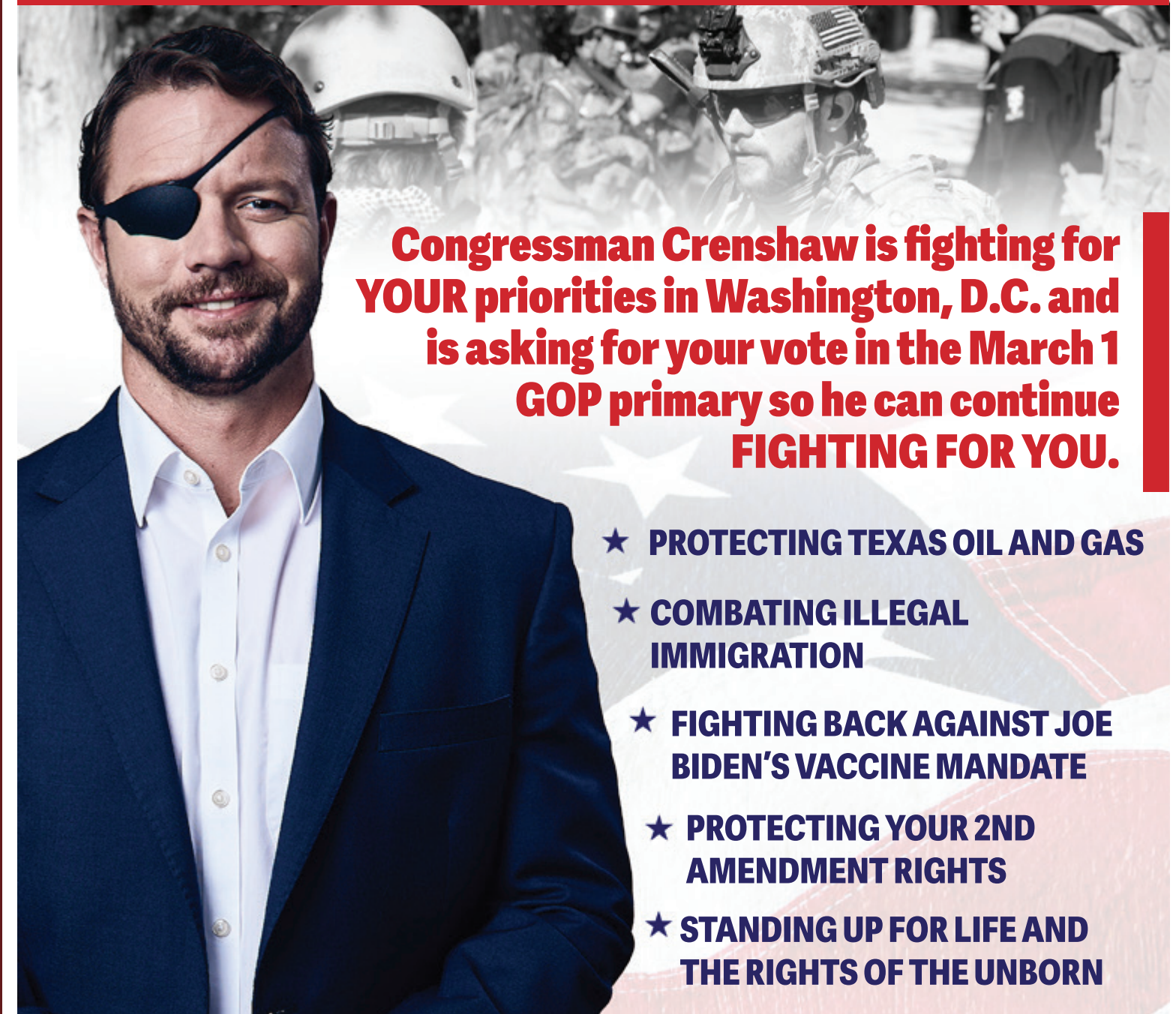
In the last session of the Texas Legislature, Governor Abbott led the way with an extremely conservative agenda which passed the anti-abortion Heartbeat Bill, pro-gun Constitutional Carry, legislation to keep boys from competing in girls' sports and the banning of Critical Race Theory in Texas classrooms.

About his tragic accident, Abbott says, "...our lives are not defined by our challenges, but by how we respond to them." There is no question that Abbott's response to adversity, and the resulting achievements on behalf of millions of Texans, have made him worthy of inclusion with other Texas patriots.

Although he hasn't faced the same adversity as Dan Crenshaw and Greg Abbott, it would be impossible not to mention Agriculture Commissioner Sid Miller in a conversation about the Texas spirit. If Hollywood were to cast the part of Texas Agriculture Commissioner, Sid Miller would likely be their first choice—he definitely looks the part in his customary jeans, boots and cowboy hat. In fact, Miller so represents the Texas ideal, that Hollywood did cast him for two cameo appearances in the television series "1883." Fortunately for Texans, Sid Miller not only looks the part, but has done an exemplary job since his election in 2014. In fact, he's done such a good job for Texas farmers and ranchers that he caught the eye of President Donald Trump who endorsed Miller and calls him "Trump's man in Texas." Miller is a graduate of Tarleton University, an 8th generation farmer and rancher, native Texan, former championship rodeo rider, ag teacher, school board member, and state representative.

Despite their impeccable records of achievement and embodiment of the Texas Spirit, Dan Crenshaw, Greg Abbott and Sid Miller have all drawn primary challengers. TCR has no doubt that these patriots will honor other legendary Texans by once again defeating the opposition and continuing their service to Texans.
